### Two Great Itinerary Options

To give Walking Connection guests the most flexibility with their Heli-hike adventure, we have designed two itineraries to choose from:

**Itinerary A** – 4 night Adventure: Includes 1-night at Mount Royal Lodge in Banff & 3 nights at Bobbie Burns Lodge.

**Itinerary B** – 3 nights at Bobbie Burns Lodge only.

### July 23 – ARRIVAL – Welcome To Canada!

**Itinerary A** – Arrive at your convenience and shuttle to Banff for overnight at Mount Royal Lodge.

**Itinerary B** — Make your own hotel and travel arrangements.

Evening Free – Overnight per Selection Above

### July 24 – Banff, Heli-pad, Bobbie Burns Lodge.

**Itinerary A** – Depart Banff. (Mount Royal Lodge pick-up time TBA).

**Itinerary B – Depart Banff** – Pick-up time TBA, depending on your hotel. You will be notified in advance. Or if you prefer to drive yourself and meet the group at the heli-pad. We'll provide detailed driving instructions.

### **Itinerary A & B – Group Transfer To Heli-pad.**

**All Bobbie Burns Lodge Heli-hikers will transfer together via motorcoach.** \*Meet Sylvia Bernardi. She is a Walking Connection Travel Curator and travel partner. She will host your adventure. Sit back and enjoy the journey through spectacular **Yoho National Park** on your way to the heli-pad. *Travel snacks and beverages included.*

**9:15 am** - Arrive at heli-pad for heli-transfer to Bobbie Burns Lodge.

**10:30 am** - Upon arrival, you'll be acquainted with the lodge and settle into your room.

**11:30 am** - Lunch

**1:00 pm** - After a helicopter safety briefing, enjoy your first short hike exploring the mountains and getting acquainted with the surrounding mountains.

**4:00 pm – 5:00 pm** Return to the lodge to enjoy après adventure refreshments, a soak in the hot tub or a massage.

**7:00 pm** - Enjoy your first heli-gourmet family-style dinner – Bobbie Burns staff will join you for the meal each evening.

### **July 25 & 26 – Itinerary A & B**

**7:30 am** - Wake up with a dynamic warm-up class.

**8:00 am** - Fuel Up with a hearty breakfast to start your day right. Pack your lunch for a day of adventure of hiking or Via Ferrata.

**9:00 am** - The first hiking group will fly into the mountains.

**Noon** - Lunch in a field of dreams.

**4:00 pm – 5:00 pm** - Return back to the lodge to enjoy après adventure refreshments, a soak in the hot tub or a massage.

**7:00 pm** - Share stories of your incredible adventures in the mountains as you enjoy family style dinner with your guides and staff.

### **July 27**

**8:00 am** - Enjoy a hearty lodge breakfast before your last heli-adventure.

**10:15 am** – All guests heli to heli-pad to meet the coach for transfer to Banff or Calgary International Airport (YYC)

**2:45 pm** Anticipated arrival at Calgary International Airport. **We recommend guests do not book flights until after 5:45pm MT.**

# Inclusions

## This Walking Connection trip includes:

- **Equipment:** Use of hiking equipment, including boots, rain jackets, wind pants, day packs, and hiking poles. Some of our guests bring their own equipment – the choice is yours.
- **Ground Transportation:** Itinerary A - From Calgary International Airport to Banff via airport shuttle, Banff to the Bobbie Burns' heli-pad, and return to Banff or Calgary International Airport. Itinerary B: by own arrangement to Banff or heli-pad.
- All activities and tours detailed in the itinerary.
- Detailed *Know Before You Go* information, including recommended website, current Covid-19 protocols, including resource information for testing if needed for entry and departure, reading lists, packing list, and weather forecast.

## This Walking Connection trip DOES NOT include:

- Local guide and driver gratuities. (Customary).
- GST and Provincial tax (approximately \$175 USD)
- All transfers outside of the itinerary schedule.
- Itinerary A & B: Airport transfer if you are not returning to Calgary with the group on July 27.
- All international and domestic airfares with tax.
- All items of a personal nature, including beverages and shopping.
- All passport and visa application fees, vaccination, and medical consulting fees.
- Covid-19 testing if required for entry into Canada or returning to country of origin.
- All international departure taxes collected at airport of departure.

# Prices, Payments, Cancellations

## Prices per person:

Itinerary A - \*\$4398.00 USD per person, double occupancy (Including 1 Night at Banff Mount Royal Lodge, 3-night heli-hike Airport Hotel).  
\*Plus \$175.00 USD for GST and Provincial tax

Itinerary B- \*\$3998.00 USD per person, double occupancy (Including three-night heli-hike only).  
\*Plus \$175.00 USD for GST and Provincial tax

**Single Occupancy:** *a limited number of single rooms may be available. Please ask for pricing.*

Tour prices are subject to change due to currency fluctuation at the time of final payment.

## Individual Guest Deposits:

- All deposits and payments are credited toward guest adventures, subject to the cancellation policy below.
- An initial deposit of \$1000.00 USD per person is required to reserve space.

Initial deposit becomes non-refundable after February 25, 2024.

For sign-ups February 26- April 14, 2024, a full non-refundable deposit is due with each reservation.

For sign-ups, April 15 – July 22, 2024, full (non-refundable) payment is due with reservation.

## Payments:

- All payments must be made according to the schedule & are subject to cancellation and penalty policy.
- Final payment is due on or before April 15, 2024.
- 0-100 days prior to the trip, reservations are sold on a space-available basis. Full payment is due at the time of each booking.
- We request that all final payments be made by check, wire transfer, or \*credit card/PayPal/Venmo.  
\*Credit card, Venmo and PayPal payments for the final amount due are subject to a 3% surcharge of the total due. Canadian (or other non-U.S. Credit cards) are subject to a 4.5% surcharge. Payments can be made online, by mail, or by phone.

## Price Variation:

Prices are based upon the current government fees for park, concession fees and sanctuary entry and all taxes at the time of publication of this information. Should the government impose any new taxes, raise the current tax or increase the entry cost to any park or sanctuary, the price increase will be passed along and charged to you. You will be notified of this increase at the time that Walking Connection is notified.

## Cancellation Policy, Penalties & Refund:

Should you cancel your adventure, the following terms will apply:

- Initial deposits are non-refundable after February 25, 2024.
- For cancellations and no-shows 0-100 prior to the trip, all payments are nonrefundable.
- No refunds will be made for any unused portion of the tour.

*All cancellations must be made in writing and delivered to the Walking Connection via e-mail and/or US Postal Service. Your cancellation date is the date your notice is received and confirmed by Walking Connection, not the date of postmark.*

## Travel Arrangements

### Travel Roommates and Single Supplements:

There is limited availability, and a supplement will apply. Please contact us for details. If you have registered for double occupancy but don't have a travel roommate, you may be charged for a Single Supplement for any portion of the trip where you will be rooming as a single.

### Trip Minimum and Maximum:

**Minimum of 11 guests.** Walking Connection specializes in traveling in small groups; many times, we stay in boutique hotel properties, historical inns, private homes, and bed & breakfasts. For this and contractual related reasons, some trips may require a minimum number of guests traveling together to go. This trip will be guaranteed to be conducted either when we have reached the minimum number of guests or evaluated 90 days prior to departure. Also, should the minimum not be met, Walking Connection may elect to operate the trip without a Walking Connection host. **Please do not make your international or domestic air arrangements until the trip is confirmed.**

### Canada Passports/Visas:

Valid passports must have one blank page and a minimum of 6 months remaining before expiration. Visas are NOT required for all US citizens.

### Trip Grading – Easy to Extreme: Each day, the choice is yours.

- Each day usually consists of 3-6 hours of activities, most centered around walking over various terrains depending on the ability of your group.
- Most days have a range of hiking levels available. Guests are placed in small groups according to their abilities, interest, and desire, and accompanied by one or two professional certified mountain guides.
- Terrain includes flower-filled meadows, ridge walks, glaciers, rocky traverses, and uphill and downhill components. Each day is determined by the weather and the ability of the group that you are hiking with.
- Via Ferrata will also be available to those that are interested.
- Your day pack will include water, snacks, mountain all-weather gear, lunch, sunscreen, personal items, and phone/camera.

## Gear & Personal Items:

We will provide a detailed list of personal items you will need that will make your journey safe and convenient. Our host property provides excellent high-end hiking boots, rain jackets, rain pants, gators, and hiking poles, at no extra charge. The lodge has an excellent drying room, so each day, your gear is dry and warm. We will publish a recommended personal gear list and packing list in the Know Before You Go prior to your adventure. We can help with information on types, brands, and what to look for if you are purchasing new gear items for the trip.

## Special Supplier Gifts & Items:

As a local custom, vendors, suppliers, ground operators, restaurants, and hotel properties may offer complimentary beverages that may or may not contain alcohol. Should you elect not to accept this gift, complimentary water may not be offered as a replacement and may only be offered for sale. This is a local custom beyond the control of Walking Connection.
