10 March

EXPLORATION OF THE CU CHI TUNNELS

Start the day with a scenic river journey to Cu Chi, where a specialist guide will introduce us to the historic tunnel network, a symbol of the Vietnam War. Explore sections open to visitors at Ben Dinh, with the option to venture underground for a first-hand experience. Above ground, there's plenty to see, so wear your sturdy footwear, sunscreen, and a hat. Afterward, enjoy a relaxed riverside lunch before returning to the city.

RAIL SIDE AND ALLEYS - URBAN WALKING TOUR

This afternoon urban walking tour is a unique opportunity to escape the hustle and bustle of downtown Saigon and enjoy a fascinating, in-depth look into the real lives of the local people. It takes you through the city's hidden backstreets, where you wander past hidden temples and bustling markets. This is an ideal opportunity to mix with the locals as they go about their daily lives.

12 March

SAIGON CONTRASTS & CULTURE

This morning, we start with a stroll in District 4 to get a glimpse of a typical morning for the Saigonese. Make a short stop at a tiny pagoda and the Xom Chieu market. We continue by car to District 7, from Tan Thuan Bridge, where you can see houseboats selling fruits and vegetables grown in the Mekong Delta.

After a leisurely lunch at a local street food favorite, our walking journey continues into central District 1. Here, we'll visit the historic Reunification Palace (formerly the Presidential Palace), where we'll explore both the main chambers and the hidden underground command bunker. Continue on foot to admire Saigon's colonial architecture, then stop by the insightful History Museum or War Remnants Museum.



Return to the hotel for a chance to freshen up before an evening with drinks and an incredible view of the city at one of the rooftop bars in the heart of bustling District 1. Located on one of the highest buildings, the venue's large open-air terrace presents uninterrupted views of downtown Saigon and beyond. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant to finish off the evening.

LIFE ON THE RAILWAY TRACKS

Accustomed to the deafening noise of the passing trains that dissect the narrow streets of the old town, the residents go about their chores – cooking, cleaning and raising their families – almost oblivious to the slow-moving trains. Pass the ageing Long Bien railway station and meet the street vendors before stopping to enjoy a refreshing drink and a taste one of Hanoi's most beloved dishes, banh cuon.

Sunday
15 March
HIGHLIGHTS OF HANOI

Afterwards, discover Tran Quoc Pagoda, the Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum complex, and the ancient Temple of Literature, before enjoying a tasty lunch at KOTO restaurant, which offers a training program that empowers disadvantaged young people.

This afternoon, you'll have the option to visit the Women's Museum and The Museum of Ethnology, or if you'd prefer, you could explore more of the bustling Old Quarter on foot at your leisure.

DAY 4
Monday
16 March
TRANSFER DAY

Depart La Sinfonia Del Rey for the 4-hour drive to Avana Retreat. The journey will take you over mountain passes as you edge closer to the green, fertile valley of Mai Chau. En route, you will also pass the scenic provincial capital city of Hao Binh. There are ample opportunities for photo-stops along this scenic stretch of road.

Upon arrival in Mai Chau, you will have lunch and then the afternoon is spent exploring local villages on foot. These villages have strong Thai cultural influence, which you will discover as you see the locals going about their daily lives, in particular working in the rice fields, planting and harvesting.

TIME AT AVANA

Whether you choose to focus your stay on wellness by making the most of the spa and yoga pavilion or decide to be more active by getting involved with any of the local craft activities available at the hotel (from Batik painting to rattan weaving), the breathtaking scenery of the majestic Mai Chau valley is bound to leave you invigorated and refreshed.

WALKING IN MAI CHAU

This walk takes you into nature and up into the hills surrounding the retreat. Follow a trail through a nearby forest with scenic views over the ethnic Thai villages below. Pass scenic villages, farmlands, bamboo forests, and rice paddies, before returning to the hotel.

MAI CHAU

Nestled in the jagged mountains of northwestern Vietnam, Mai Chau is known for its breathtaking landscapes and rich cultural heritage. This peaceful valley has long been home to the Ban Lac people, the largest ethnic group in the region. While it has become a popular destination, the area has held onto its traditional way of life. Visitors can experience an authentic glimpse into Vietnam's vibrant minority cultures—an essential and enduring part of the country's identity.



DAY 5
Tuesday
17 March

EXPLORING PU LUONG

Depart from Avana early morning and embark on a scenic journey through the mountain roads to Pu Luong Nature Reserve (located about 50km away from Mai Chau). Trek through traditional villages, gently sloping terraced rice fields, and bamboo forests.

YOUR STAY

Avana Retreat, 2 Of 2 nights

Bauhinia Mountain Suite – Breakfast/Lunch

A peaceful hotel located in the mountains of Mai Chau, Avana Resort is the perfect place to soak up the rural scenery and relax.

NINH BINH

A sound base for exploring the Vietnamese countryside, Ninh Binh is just inland from the famous Halong Bay. The town itself is rather dusty and unattractive; however, to the south, the nearby village of Tam Coc is renowned for its limestone cliffs and karst scenery. Opposite it sits one of Vietnam's ancient capitals, Hoa Lu. Not much remains of this 10th-century royal city apart from some intricate archways and the atmospheric dynastic temples of Dinh Tien Hoang, Nhat Tru Temple, and Le Dai Hanh.



DAY 6
Wednesday
18 March
MAI CHAU TO NINH BINH

After breakfast, you'll travel to Ninh Binh, taking in the breathtaking scenery along the way. The total driving time will be approximately 3.5 hours. On the way to the hotel, stop at Van Long Nature Reserve for a walk through its scenic landscape of rice paddies, limestone hills, and rivers. After lunch, enjoy a sampan boat ride through the reserve before checking in.

Oasis Deluxe – Breakfast/Lunch

Surrounded by paddy fields and dramatic limestone hills, the hotel has locally inspired décor and is a great option for exploring Ninh Binh and the surrounding area.

19 March
EXPLORING NINH BINH

Today, you will explore some incredible sights and scenery Ninh Binh offers. From the viewpoint at Hang Mua, to the Bich Dong Pagoda, to the remarkable Thien Ha cave, the journey is also part of the experience in this incredible area.

DAY 8
Friday
20 March
NINH BINH TO HA LONG BAY PIER

The journey from Jiva Hoa Lu Retreat to Ha Long Bay Pier ready for your cruise should take around 4 hours. You will set off early in the morning.

YOUR STAY
Ylang Junk Boat, 1 of 2 nights
Signature/Regency/Premium Regency Suite – Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

A traditional junk boat with 10 spacious suites, a library and a restaurant. This is a luxurious way to explore the less-visited Lan Ha Bay. The boat has a wellness-focused spa, Tai Chi sessions, and gourmet dining. There is the chance to explore Viet Hai Village on Cat Ba Island, kayak among limestone cliffs, and unwind on the terrace deck or in the Jacuzzi pool. This two-night cruise is perfect for rejuvenation and scenic discovery.



HALONG BAY

Ha Long Bay, an impressive UNESCO World Heritage site, is steeped in myth and legend. Ha Long means the 'descending dragon' - the story goes that Vietnam was sent a family of dragons as protection against invaders. The dragons spat out jewels and jade from their mouths which transformed into the islands and islets you can now see spanning the bay. The best way to appreciate the famous picturesque ocean karst topography of this area is to board a boat and cruise around the bay.

CRUISE

Today, you'll take a short speedboat transfer to your luxurious floating home. Settle into your cabin and enjoy lunch in the elegant restaurant with a 360-degree view. Afterwards, relax on the terrace deck or enjoy Ylang's spa facilities and the plunge pool as you cruise towards Cat Ba Island. Here, hop onto bicycles (or an electric cart if you prefer) for a tour along small, paved roads towards Viet Hai village. There are opportunities to meet the people who live in this self-sufficient fishing and farming community within Cat Ba National Park, learn about the fruits and vegetables grown in the valley and try some homemade spirits. Back on board, you might choose an activity, such as a tea tasting class or food carving demonstration, while the boat cruises to a tranquil overnight mooring spot and dinner is served.



DAY 9
Saturday
21 March

CRUISE

Join a Tai Chi session this morning before breakfast. Ylang will cruise towards the southern tip of Cat Ba Island today. Board a tender to visit an authentic floating fishing village near Ben Beo and see how this unique community lives and works on the water. Take a leisurely walk in Cat Ba National Park. The Park is a biosphere reserve with a diverse array of plants, birds, reptiles, and mammals, including deer, macaques, and civets.

Back on board, relax over lunch as Ylang resumes its journey northeast through the stony labyrinth of Lan Ha Bay, heading for a secluded mooring spot. Choose from kayaking, swimming and even an optional guided meditation session this afternoon. And after dinner, you might choose to soothe your body and mind with a guided "Singing Bowl Meditation" ceremony, or unwind on your private balcony while taking in the tranquility of Lan Ha Bay.

DAY 10
Sunday
22 March

CRUISE

Join an open-air session of Tai Chi before enjoying a light snack to accompany your delicious, traditional Vietnamese coffee. Then your boat captain will find another quiet spot to offer you one last chance to go kayaking or take a refreshing morning swim.
